Application Process: I hereby apply to be a volunteer Coach/Manager for TPLL. In addition to this application, Little League Inc. requires all volunteers to submit a Volunteer Application. I understand this evaluation requires me to provide my Social Security number for a background check and is conducted solely to assure the safety of children participating in the TPLL program and that all information obtained will be held in strict confidence in accordance with applicable law.

Manager/Coach Selection Policy: In addition to teaching baseball and administering a team, managers and coaches of TPLL hold a position of trust and responsibility in a program that deals with a sensitive and formative period of a child's development. It is required that the manager and coach have the understanding, patience and capacity to work with children. The manager and coach should inspire respect. Above all else, managers and coaches must realize that they are helping to shape the physical, mental and emotional development of young people.

TPLL is seeking coaches who not only possess knowledge of baseball fundamentals and the ability to teach these fundamentals, but more importantly individuals who will instill a sense of self-confidence, pride, and good sportsmanship while serving as role models for players and parents. The TPLL Board evaluates candidates based upon these standards, as well as participation in league activities and meeting administrative requirements, including the prompt return of player evaluations, uniforms (if distributed), and equipment. Evidence of these attributes is collected from a variety of sources, including TPLL Board experiences and feedback from players and parents. Coaching/managing a team one year is not a guarantee of being selected to manage a team in any other year. No manager or coach has tenure, regardless of years of service to TPLL. As such, the TPLL Board may not provide reasons to any candidate if that person is not re-appointed or selected as a Coach/Manger for the coming season.
